


Survey responses per country (n=420)








Survey responses per stakeholder (n=574)








Professional involvement in open access (n=420)






















Which of the following policies/ recommendations are you familiar with?








How important are the following stakeholders for the implementation of open access book policies in your country?








How important should the following stakeholders be for the implementation of open access book policies in your country?













Anmerkungen

- Die Umfrageergebnisse betonen die Wichtigkeit der Verbesserung vor Finanzierungsmöglichkeiten für Open Access-Bücher
- Die Open Access-Transformation würde von der Vereinheitlichung von Open Access-Strategien und -Richtlinien durch Forschungsförderer profitieren (→ wahrscheinliche Erhöhung von Sichtbarkeit und besonders Verständlichkeit der Policy-Landschaft)
- Notwendigkeit für verbesserte Informationsbereitstellung und erhöhte Aktivität bzgl. Publizieren von Open Access-Büchern
- Bibliometrische Daten für (Open Access-) Bücher müssen dringend an Qualität gewinnen, um die Entwicklung der Open Access-Transformation für Bücher bewerten zu können
