

## The Dark Side

- A "dark" digital archive is a closed repository that strictly controls individual and/or organizational access to the information stored within it.
- It's about research publication (and other output) management by researchers and their research administrators.
- It's NOT about open access and discovery.

## Why do we have a closed repository?


- Originated from RAE 2008.
- Not all was suitable for our existing OA repo (Edinburgh Research Archive) and there was not much full-text (a requirement of ERA).
- Initially developed a bespoke repository but decided to migrate to DSpace.
- Keeping an eye on the REF.

# Authorisation

- PR is behind CoSign (effectively LDAP) protection.
- Matches user to their own collection.
- Each researcher only has submit rights to their own collection.
- The community admin feature allows us to designate school admins as community admins.
- Specific group of Cataloguers that are responsible for the workflow stage.
