


- Article**  
An article in a journal, magazine, newspaper. Not necessarily peer-reviewed. May be an electronic-only medium, such as an online journal or news website.
- Book**  
A book or a conference volume.
- Book Section**  
A chapter or section in a book.
- Edited Book**  
An edited version of a book.
- Scholarly Edition**  
A scholarly edition of a book.
- Research Report or Paper**  
A research report or paper, and also a finding aid or catalogue.
- Conference Proceedings**  
A peer-reviewed paper given at a conference.
- Patent**  
A published patent. Do *not* include as yet unpublished patent applications.
- Artefact**  
An artist's artefact or work product.
- Exhibition**  
An artist's exhibition or site specific performance-based deposit.
- Composition**  
A musical composition.
- Performance**  
Performance of a musical or theatrical event.
- Audio**  
A sound recording.
- Research Database or Dataset**  
A bounded collection of quantitative data (e.g. spreadsheet or XML data file).





#### Abstract

This paper provide details of the work and the lessons learned by the JISC funded Enrich project run by the University of Glasgow in the United Kingdom. Enrich provided a clear focus for the integration and enhancement of the University of Glasgow's repository, Enlighten, with other institutional systems, including our Research System [CRIS] (for funder data) and our Data Vault (for staff records). The Enrich project has demonstrated that partnership between the University Library and the Research Office, in conjunction with researchers, administrators and IT Services is critical to ensuring the successful integration of a repository and a CRIS. Enrich is part of a wider JISC funded programme in the UK: "Information Environment 2009-11" which focuses on the management, discovery and use of information resources. It was completed at the end of March 2010.
